Kiltyclogher Heritage Centre houses an exhibition about the 1916 Proclamation signatory Seán MacDiarmada. The exhibition contains an audio-visual facility and interpretive panels, providing visitors with information about Seán MacDiarmada and the history of the locality.

Guided tours to Seán MacDiarmada's house will take you on a journey through time. Travelling from Seán's memorial statue to the glacial valley of Corranmore. Step into the past to arrive at the wonderfully preserved vernacular cottage of the MacDiarmada homestead.

Seán MacDiarmada's Cottage

CO. LEITRIM



Visit the house of the 1916 Easter Rising leader Seán MacDiarmada in Kiltyclogher, County Leitrim.

This beautiful cottage is a designated National Monument, owned and maintained in its original condition by the Office of Public Works. The cottage is of considerable historic importance, as it is the only original existing home place of any of the seven signatories of the proclamation. It is also a fine example of a traditional Irish cottage, offering an insight to what life was like over 100 years ago.

Seán MacDiarmada played a pivotal role in planning the Easter Rising of 1916. He was one of the seven signatories that signed the Proclamation of Irish Independence. Following his arrest after the Rising he was court martialed and executed by firing squad on 12th of May 1916 in the Stone-Breaker's Yard in Kilmainham Gaol.

Tabhair cuairt ar theach Sheáin Mhic Dhiarmada, duine de cheannairí Éirí Amach na Cásca 1916, i gCoillte Clochair, Contae Liatroma.

Tá an teachín gleoite seo ainmnithe mar Shéadchomhartha Náisiúnta faoi úinéireacht Oifig na nOibreacha Poiblí. Coinníonn an OOP an teachín ina bhunriocht i gcónaí mar go bhfuil tábhacht stairiúil ar leith ag gabháil leis. Is é an t-aon teach baile d'aon duine den seachtar a shínigh an Forógra atá fós ar marthain inniu agus mar aon leis sin is eiseamláir bhreá é de theachín traidisiúnta na hÉireann, agus léargas le fáil ann ar shaol na ndaoine os cionn 100 bliain ó shin.

Bhí páirt lárnach ag Seán MacDiarmada sa phleanáil d'Éirí Amach na Cásca 1916. Bhí sé ar an seachtar sínitheoirí a chuir a n-ainm le Forógra na Poblachta. Gabhadh é i ndiaidh an Éirí Amach agus cuireadh faoi thriail armchúirte é. Chuir scud lámhaigh chun báis é ar an 12 Bealtaine 1916 i gClós na mBristeoirí Cloch i bPríosún Chill Mhaighneann.



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
